

#### **ADDITIONAL NOTES**

 PASSPORTS/PASSPORT CARDS. U.S. citizens entering the U.S. from Canada must have a U.S. PASSPORT or PASSPORT CARD. (\*\*see exception below.) We will keep you posted travel requirements, should there be any last minute changes.

(The Passport Card is designed for folks who don't intend travel by air or beyond Canada, Mexico, or the Caribbean.) If you're considering this trip and don't have a current passport, be sure you apply for one soon! Tioga County residents start at the Prothonotary's office at the Court House in Wellsboro (570-724-9281). Estimated turn-around time: 4-6 weeks.
